Admission to the following courses is offered on the percentages shown against each course. This offer is subject to the following conditions:

1. Document verification, approval of admission will be done from **06.07.2018 to 09.07.2018** (except Sunday). After approval of admission, online admission fee payment will be made on DU admission portal till 12:00 noon of the next day of the given admission list deadline (i.e. **Upto 12:00 noon of 10.07.2018**).
2. The applicants shall be required to produce the following documents in original with two sets of self-attested photocopies at the time of admission:
 - a) Class VIII mark-sheet
 - b) Class X board examination certificate
 - c) Class X mark-sheet
 - d) Class XII mark-sheet
 - e) Class XII provisional certificate / original certificate
 - f) Recent Character Certificate
 - g) SC/ST/PWD/CW/KM certificate (in the name of the applicant) issued by the competent authority
 - h) OBC (non-creamy layer) certificate (in the name of the applicant) as in central list
 - i) Transfer Certificate from school / college as well as migration certificate from board / university are required from those students who have passed senior secondary exam from outside Delhi
 - j) At least six passport size self-attested photographs.
 - k) A copy of Aadhar Card.
 - l) Print out of college-cum-course allotment letter downloaded from DU portal
